Staff Recommendation

The Board of Directors accepts this report and approves the 120-day written notice to Cal Fire requesting defunding of the Mechanic (HEM) classification from the Cooperative Fire Programs Fire Protection Reimbursement Agreement 1 CA 66716.

Background

The Fire District has been without a mechanic (HEM) for the previous ten (10) months. As a result, District staff has obtained fleet service and repairs from the following agencies:

- 1. Alameda County Fire Fleet Services
- 2. Redwood City Fleet Services
- 3. Regional Governmental Services

The services provided by the aforementioned agencies have consistently met the District's fleet service/repair requirements. In particular, the Alameda County Fire Fleet Services has proven to be a reliable, timely and cost effective resource.

Discussion

Based upon the demonstrated performance over the ten-month period, and proven cost effectiveness of the contractual services, staff recommends defunding the mechanic position in the cooperative agreement. This will result in an approximate \$162,000 annual cost savings to the District.
