1. OPEN SESSION

President Burke called to order the regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Coastside Fire Protection District at 6:00 p.m.

A. Review and Approve Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018

Assistant Chief Cole introduced the proposed Final Budget, indicated that Staff met with the Finance Committee, summarized some of the main aspects of the Budget, and recommended approval of the Final Budget.

B. Review and Approve Updated CalFire Contract Deliverables Fiscal Year 2017-2018

Assistant Chief Cole provided comments and reported that the flag pole lights that were requested at Stations 40 and 41 have been installed.

ON MOTION by President Burke, seconded by Secretary McShane, the Board approved the updated CalFire Annual Deliverables. Motion passed 4-0.

A. Finance Committee Report

President Burke reported there was a Finance Committee meeting and they went over the new Budget.

B. Volunteer Liaison Report

Vice President Cockrell reported he attended the September 7 volunteer meeting. They discussed bills and general financial matters. Their current balance is approximately \$192,500. He indicated the CalFire Volunteers Golf Tournament will be held on October 29, 2017 at the Half Moon Bay Links. The crab and salmon feed is scheduled for April 7, 2018. They also discussed training.

He expressed his appreciation to the Board for the Training Prop, after him working on this project for 19 years.


