1. **OPEN SESSION**

President Burke called to order the regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Coastside Fire Protection District at 6:00 p.m.

6. NEW BUSINESS

A. <u>Selection of Board Committee Members/Liaisons</u>

President Burke indicated that one additional liaison position needs to be filled, that of liaison to the Volunteer Committee.

ON MOTION by President Burke, seconded by Director MacKimmie, the Board voted unanimously for Director Steve Stockman to be the liaison to the Volunteer Committee with Vice President J.B. Cockrell. Motion passed 4-0.

B. <u>Review and Discuss Entering Into a New Cooperative Agreement with</u> <u>CalFire</u>

President Burke provided background and comments on this issue. He initiated a discussion regarding an extension of the CalFire contract or perhaps a new 10-year contract with CalFire. Extensive discussion occurred between the Board and Assistant Chief Cole.

ON MOTION by President Burke, seconded by Vice President Cockrell, the Board voted unanimously to take the initial steps to contact CalFire and initiate the process on their end to provide a new long-term contract to the Coastside Fire Protection District. Motion passed 4-0.

C. <u>Review and Discuss District's Updated Vehicle Replacement Schedule</u>

President Burke provided comments on this and suggested postponing it to a future Board meeting.

Assistant Chief Cole also provided comments on this issue.

D. <u>Review, Discuss and Take Action on Naming New Training Complex</u>

President Burke provided background on this issue and detailed Assistant Chief Cole's crucial role in the activities that made the Training Prop a reality.

ON MOTION by President Burke, seconded by Director MacKimmie, the Board voted unanimously that the Training Prop be named the Chief Paul Cole Training Complex and that a brass plaque be attached to the Training Prop. Motion passed 4-0.

Assistant Chief Cole conveyed his thanks to the Board for the honor.

ON MOTION by Director MacKimmie, seconded by Director Stockman, the Board voted unanimously to authorize Staff to advertise for a weed abatement contractor. Motion passed 4-0.

7. BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND CHIEFS' REPORTS

A. <u>Finance Committee Report</u>

President Burke reported there was no Finance Committee meeting this month. He referred to items on the Monthly Expense Report. He also referred to the PARS Report for the month of November.

B. <u>Volunteer Liaison Report</u>

Vice President J.B. Cockrell reported his attendance at the December 7th meeting. Items discussed were fundraisers, finances, total balance in checking and savings account, and normal business things. He said they

needed to reinstate their 501(c)(3) status and were able to have the \$10,000 fine waived. Also discussed were scholarships for high school seniors and a training report by Captain Lutz.
